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I. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO THE UPPER LEVEL COURSEWORK OF THE PROGRAM

The following courses are sequenced to indicate “preparedness” for upper level coursework.

a. Complete the following courses with a grade of “C” or better:

ENGL 103/104	COMM 203/205	BIOL 107/111	CHEM 119	
BIOL 319	BIOL 320	HLTH 210	HLTH 231	HLTH 240

- Student should refer to professional school prerequisites to know which Biology to take (BIOL 107 or BIOL 111).

b. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU (must have 15 graded hours at TAMU).

All courses must be completed or in progress before registering for upper level coursework. The purpose of this course sequencing is to present material in a logical and orderly way to lay a foundation for students. Once students have this foundation, they will be prepared for the rigors of upper level coursework.

II. DIRECTED ELECTIVES

Students must select courses from the Allied Health Directed Electives List (*in degree plan packet*) to satisfy the 22 hour directed elective requirement.

III. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Students must take **36 hours of 300-499 level** course work from TAMU. If students complete all courses of the Allied Health degree requirements at TAMU, then students will meet the Residency requirement set by the University. Students who transfer in some courses from community college may need to take more 300-499 level hours in order to meet this requirement. *See Residency Worksheet in packet.*

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

- a) Submit departmental *Intent to Graduate Survey* by the deadline, which is **two semesters before graduation** semester. Your advisor will email you the specific deadline dates for each semester along with a link to the survey.
 - Fall graduation: Spring semester
 - Spring graduation: Summer semester
 - Summer graduation: Fall semester.
- b) Successfully complete ALL degree plan courses with the required grade in each.
- c) Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 overall at TAMU
- d) Apply for Graduation and pay Diploma Fee the semester you are graduating.
- e) Transfer all applicable courses to Texas A&M University Admission Office.

V. PROGRESS TOWARDS DEGREE

Students must show progress towards their degree by completing a combined total of 24 credit hours on their degree plan during the fall and spring semesters. At the end of the spring semester, students who did not complete 24 credit hours on their degree plan will be placed on probation. They must complete at least 12 hours on their degree plan plus make up any additional hours not completed the year before during the next fall semester. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the department.

VI. DEGREE PLANNER REQUIREMENT

All students are required by TEC§51.9685 (formerly House Bill 3025) to complete an online undergraduate degree plan annually. The Undergraduate Degree Planner can be found in the Howdy Portal on the My Record tab in the Undergraduate Degree Planner channel. Guides for using the Undergraduate Degree Planner are also available in Howdy. The Degree Planner typically opens for submission on March 1st and is due for the Health & Kinesiology by August 1st. The Degree Planner is accessible at any time to plan future semesters.

VII. COURSE FORCING

The Health & Kinesiology Department will not force students into any course that does not fall within our department (i.e. HLTH, KINE, and SPMT). If a student is entering their final semester before graduation and needs a course that falls within the Health & Kinesiology Department, they may be able to be forced into that course depending on classroom space. If a course falls outside of the Health & Kinesiology Department, students will need to contact the college and/or department in which that course is housed in order to see if they can be forced in.

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Directed Electives

Students must select courses from the list below to satisfy the 22 hour professional development electives requirement. Directed electives may be used to satisfy requirements to attend professional school in an Allied Health area. Students are responsible for knowing the requirements for the professional school they pursue. In addition, any other health class not already on the degree plan (with the exception of HLTH 415, 421, 425, 440 and 484) can also be used as a directed elective.

*The list below reflects courses that are required by all or some of the professional school(s) in Texas. Please visit with the **Professional School Advising Office (opsa.tamu.edu)** to learn more about the specific requirements of the school(s) you wish to apply for admission. Each professional school will have its own requirements.
