GENERAL RULES COMMUNITY HEALTH CATALOG 142

I. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE PROFESSIONAL PHASE OF THE PROGRAM The Professional Phase indicates "preparedness" for upper level coursework

1. Complete ENGL 103/104 and COMM 203 requirement with a minimum "B/C" grade combination.

- 3. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU (must have 15 graded hours at TAMU)
- 4. Submit the Application Form. Professional Phase application form is available from the departmental website (mycehd.tamu.edu). Applications are accepted in the Fall for Spring Acceptance, Spring for Summer Acceptance, Summer for Fall Acceptance. Your advisor will email you the deadline dates for each semester. Application deadlines will also be posted on the MyCEHD website as well.

Handwritten or late applications will not be accepted.

NOTE: Approximately 3-4 weeks after the application deadline you will receive official preliminary notification of your acceptance or denial into the professional phase of the program and you will be able to check <u>http://howdy.tamu.edu</u> to see that your status has been changed from Community Health (Lower) to Community Health for the next semester. This will allow you to register for professional phase courses. If you do not meet requirements by approximately two weeks after TAMU grades are posted for the semester, you will receive official notification of your denial into the professional phase of the program.

Enrollment Management: Entrance to professional phase is a **COMPETITIVE** process. The number of applicants selected will be determined by faculty and available internship opportunities. Up to 75 students will be selected during the academic year (30 in the Fall, 30 in the Spring, and 15 in the Summer).

II. Health Electives

Students must select 14 hours of coursework from the Health Electives List (listed on the spreadsheet) to satisfy the health elective requirement. This coursework must be completed before students may enroll in their internship (HLTH 484).

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNSHIP

- 1. Submit Intent to Graduate form prior to the deadline. This is due by deadline (announced each semester): the <u>SEMESTER BEFORE ENROLLING</u> in the pre-internship courses (HLTH 415, 425 & 440) (Excluding summer).
- 2. A grade of "C" or better MUST be made in each of the following: ENGL/COMM, Math, Science Foundation, Professional Development and Major Courses. This applies to those courses taken at Texas A&M and those taken elsewhere and transferred to Texas A&M.
- 3. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU.

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

1. Successfully complete ALL degree plan courses with required grade in each

- 2. Add/Pay Diploma Fee the semester you are graduating/interning.
- 3. Apply for graduation the semester you are graduating/interning.
- 4. Transfer ALL applicable coursework to TAMU Admission's office
- 5. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU
- V. **PROGRESS TOWARDS DEGREE-** Students must show progress towards their degree by completing a combined total of 24 credit hours on their degree plan during the fall and spring semesters. At the end of the spring semester, students who did not complete 24 credit hours on their degree plan will be placed on probation. They must complete at least 12 hours on their degree plan plus make up any additional hours not completed the year before during the next fall semester. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the department.

VI. Undergraduate Degree Planner Requirement

All students entering Texas A&M University in fall 2013 or later are required by TEC§51.9685 (formerly House Bill 3025) to complete an online undergraduate degree plan. Students are required to complete the Undergraduate Degree Planner before the start date of their second year. The Undergraduate Degree Planner is in Howdy on the My Record tab in the Undergraduate Degree Planner channel. Guides for using the Undergraduate Degree Planner are also available in Howdy.

VII. COURSE FORCING

The Health & Kinesiology Department will not force students into any course that does not fall within our department (i.e. HLTH, KINE, and SPMT). If a student is entering their final semester before graduation and needs a course that falls within the Health & Kinesiology Department, they may be able to be forced into that course depending on classroom space. If a course falls outside of the Health & Kinesiology Department, students will need to contact the college and/or department in which that course is housed in order to see if they can be forced in.
