I. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO THE UPPER LEVEL COURSEWORK OF THE PROGRAM

The following courses are sequenced to indicate “preparedness” for upper level coursework.

1. Complete the following courses with a grade of “C” or better:
ENGL 103/104 COMM 203/205 BIOL 107/111 CHEM 119 BIOL 319 BIOL 320
HLTH 210 HLTH 222 HLTH 231 HLTH 240 HLTH 331
 - a. Student should refer to professional school prerequisites to know which Biology to take (BIOL 107 or BIOL 111).
2. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU (must have 15 graded hours at TAMU)

All courses must be completed or in progress before registering for upper level coursework. The purpose of this course sequencing is to present material in a logical and orderly way to lay a foundation for students. Once students have this foundation, they will be prepared for the rigors of upper level coursework.

II. Health Electives

Students must select 11 hours of coursework from the Health Electives List (listed on the spreadsheet) to satisfy the health elective requirement. This coursework must be completed before students may enroll in their internship (HLTH 484).

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNSHIP

1. Submit Intent to Graduate form prior to the deadline. This is due by deadline (announced each semester): the **SEMESTER BEFORE ENROLLING** in the pre-internship courses (HLTH 415, 425 & 440) (**Excluding summer**).
2. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU.

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

1. Successfully complete ALL degree plan courses with required grade in each
2. Add/Pay Diploma Fee the semester you are graduating/interning.
3. Apply for graduation the semester you are graduating/interning.
4. Transfer ALL applicable coursework to TAMU Admission’s office
5. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU

- V. PROGRESS TOWARDS DEGREE-** Students must show progress towards their degree by completing a combined total of 24 credit hours on their degree plan during the fall and spring semesters. At the end of the spring semester, students who did not complete 24 credit hours on their degree plan will be placed on probation. They must complete at least 12 hours on their degree plan plus make up any additional hours not completed the year before during the next fall semester. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the department.

VI. Degree Planner Requirement

All students are required by TEC§51.9685 (formerly House Bill 3025) to complete an online undergraduate degree plan annually. The Undergraduate Degree Planner can be found in the Howdy Portal on the My Record tab in the Undergraduate Degree Planner channel. Guides for using the Undergraduate Degree Planner are also available in Howdy. The Degree Planner typically opens for submission on March 1st and is due for the Health & Kinesiology by August 1st. The Degree Planner is accessible at any time to plan future semesters.

VII. COURSE FORCING

The Health & Kinesiology Department will not force students into any course that does not fall within our department (i.e. HLTH, KINE, and SPMT). If a student is entering their final semester before graduation and needs a course that falls within the Health & Kinesiology Department, they may be able to be forced into that course depending on classroom space. If a course falls outside of the Health & Kinesiology Department, students will need to contact the college and/or department in which that course is housed in order to see if they can be forced in.
