**I. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO THE UPPER LEVEL COURSEWORK OF THE PROGRAM**

The following courses are sequenced to indicate “preparedness” for upper level coursework.

1. Complete the following courses with a grade of “C” or better:

- a. Student should refer to professional school prerequisites to know which Biology to take (BIOL 107 or BIOL 111).
2. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU (must have 15 graded hours at TAMU).

All courses must be completed or in progress before registering for upper level coursework. The purpose of this course sequencing is to present material in a logical and orderly way to lay a foundation for students. Once students have this foundation, they will be prepared for the rigors of upper level coursework.

**II. Health Electives**

Students must select 11 hours of coursework from the Health Electives List (listed on the spreadsheet) to satisfy the health elective requirement. This coursework must be completed before students may enroll in their internship (HLTH 484).

**III. REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNSHIP**

1. Submit Intent to Graduation Survey prior to the deadline. This is due by deadline (announced each semester): the **SEMESTER PRIOR TO ENROLLING** in the pre-internship courses (HLTH 415, 425, 440) (**Excluding Summer**).
2. All coursework must be completed by the time of the internship semester.
3. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU.

**IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION**

1. Successfully complete ALL degree plan courses with required grade in each.
2. Add/Pay Diploma Fee the semester you are graduating/interning.
3. Apply for graduation the semester you are graduating/interning.
4. Transfer ALL applicable coursework to TAMU Admission’s office.
5. Minimum GPR Requirement: 2.5 Overall at TAMU

**V. PROGRESS TOWARDS DEGREE**

Student Rule 1.5.1 states: “A student is expected to register for a schedule of courses that follows the program of study for a degree in his or her college. A student who elects not to follow the program of study must obtain approval from his or her academic advisor. A student who fails to obtain approval may be held from registration, removed from the inappropriate course(s) and/or required to register for a prescribed schedule of courses.” Advisors will periodically check to ensure you are taking classes towards your degree. If you are planning to change majors or take prerequisites for professional school, please let your advisor know.

Student Rule 12.1 – 12.2 - Students must maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA at all times. Those who do not meet the minimum GPA requirements may be placed on academic probation or dismissed from their major.

**VI. DEGREE PLANNER REQUIREMENT**

All students are required by TEC§51.9685 (formerly House Bill 3025) to complete an online undergraduate degree plan once every year until graduation. The Undergraduate Degree Planner and a guide detailing how to complete it are located in Howdy on the My Record tab under the Undergraduate Degree Planner channel. This is not a substitute for advising, and approval of your Undergraduate Degree Planner does NOT ensure you are meeting all of the requirements for graduation. The Degree Planner typically opens for submission on March 1st and is due for Health students by August 1st. The Degree Planner is accessible at any time to plan for future semesters. NOTE: When students complete 30+ credit hours, they will receive a notification outlining the requirement for them to complete and submit their undergraduate degree planner (even if students are still in their first semester). For these students, the degree planner must be approved before they can register for the following semester’s courses.

**VII. COURSE FORCING**

The department will not force students into any course that does not fall within our department (i.e. HLTH, KINE, and SPMT). If a student is entering their final semester before graduation and needs a course that falls within the department, they may be able to be forced into that course depending on classroom space. If a course falls outside of the department, students will need to contact the college and/or can be forced in.
