Faculty Research Excellence Award

In the spirit of the School of Public Health's commitment to research, the School annually recognizes one Early Career (applicant is within 10 years of terminal degree at time of application due date) and one Associate/Full Professor with the Dean's Research Excellence Award.*

Nomination Process: Investigators may self-nominate or may be nominated by a committee or SPH peers. The nomination form is attached.

I. Eligibility:

- a. Nominees must be full-time SPH faculty members at the Assistant or Associate Full Professor level. Tenure/Tenure Track and Non-Tenure Track are eligible.
- b. Past winners are ineligible to reapply for 3 award cycles after their initial award. Ex. If awarded in 2018, recipient may not reapply until 2022.

II. Measures.

Awardees are selected based on their overall productivity and contributions to the field of public health to include:

- Publications: Impact of work in the field
- Record of Extramural Funding (last 3 years)
- Interdisciplinary research
- Visibility at the national and international level
- Participation as invited speaker, session chair, panel member
- Special awards and recognition
- Mentorship of students and faculty

III. Nomination Materials:

The nomination packet includes the following. Incomplete packets will not be considered.

- a. Application form-attached (3 pages maximum)
- b. CV

IV. Selection Committee

The SPH Dean and Associate Dean for Research will review the applications and select the winners. All decisions are final. If more than 5 applications are received in a category, the Research Committee will screen applications in advance for conformance to guidelines and make recommendations for awardee selection.

V. Timeline

- a. January- call for nominees.
- b. February applications due
- c. March- committee reviews
- d. April- winners selected

VI. Award

Recipient receives a one-time monetary award for profession development or personal use (=\$500), a certificate of recognition/ display of recipients name wherever designated by dean (online, annual SPH newsstand, alumni newsletters, magazine, etc.), and recognition at a Faulty meeting.

*Awards may be granted to Early Career and Associate/Full in alternating years at the Dean's discretion.
