

## **Call for Posters**

## SPH Public Health Week Celebration White Creek Community Center – Multi-Purpose Room 116

In honor of the American Public Health Association- Public Health Week, The School of Public Health is hosting a research symposium on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The poster session is an opportunity for the school to showcase the accomplishments of faculty, graduate, and undergraduate students. Graduate and undergraduate students are asked to participate in a poster competition.

- Awards will be given for the top three student poster presentations in each category.
- The top two student research posters in each category will be invited to compete for slots in the Annual Delta Omega Student Poster Session during APHA's Annual Conference to be held in Atlanta, Nov 12<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>,2023.

Appropriate topics for student posters include a range of on-going SPH activities including:

-Research -Outreach -Practice

Students should consult with their faculty advisors regarding the content of abstracts and posters.

**Submission Requirements**: Students interested in participating are asked to submit an abstract by **Tuesday February 28, 2023,** to the following link: <a href="https://forms.gle/aJUYkUWLt4STe1JE7">https://forms.gle/aJUYkUWLt4STe1JE7</a>. Please include the title of the poster, corresponding authors, and department. Notice of poster acceptance will be sent out on March 6<sup>th</sup> by 5 PM. Two poster workshops, one for graduate students and one for undergraduate students, will be held in February to offer guidance in poster design and presentation.

\*NOTE: We encourage participation and collaborations with students from other colleges. The NPHW Symposium is a great opportunity to showcase your research and receive input from fellow students and faculty. However, monetary awards will only be available for School of Public Health students.

## **POSTER GUIDELINES:**

Poster Setup: Monday April 3, 2023, from 2:00PM to 5:00 PM

**Poster Removal:** Friday April 7<sup>th</sup> (after 2PM)

**Display Board:** Posters will be displayed on stand-alone bulletin boards (provided by SPH). The dimensions are 69 inches tall X 58 inches wide.

**Poster Size:** The standard poster size is approximately 36 inches tall X 48 inches wide.

**Font Type:** Use simple to read fonts such as Ariel, Helvetica, or Verdana. Be consistent throughout poster presentation.

**Title**: The banner across top should include the title, author(s), and affiliations. SPH and HSC seals are recommended for inclusion in the banner.
